As a resident of Stamford and a constituent of state Rep. Rachel Khanna, I want to take a moment to highlight the incredible work she has done for our community. Over the course of her term representing the 149th District, Rachel has been instrumental in securing significant financial resources that have directly benefited our local schools, infrastructure, and community programs.

Through her leadership, our district has received nearly \$100 million in state funding. This includes more than \$70 million dedicated to public school building projects, such as the \$51 million renovation of Stamford's Roxbury Elementary School and the \$20 million rebuild of Greenwich's Central Middle School.
